Packed Lunches Update

Just to let you know that at our recent Food Hygiene Inspection we were awarded a score of 5, which is the top grade once again. This grading is for our hygiene and procedures when preparing and serving the meals you send to nursery. However, we were asked by the Food Safety Inspector to pass on the following information to you:

It is very important that, when you are sending food to nursery, it has been prepared in the correct way and is thoroughly cooked. It must also be cooled down as quickly as possible and put straight into the fridge.

In addition, When being transported to nursery the food must be accompanied in your child's box or bag by an ice pack to maintain a safe storage temperature.
